
SOL kicked off the new year with journal entry number six:

The YC Student Government Team has been busy over winter break composing the YCSGA Constitution and coordinating spring events. They kicked off the spring semester with many Meet and Greets. They presented to the ELT, Deans, Faculty Senate, Yavapai College Staff Association and will be finishing up with a Student Event on February 5th.







Early College and Promise

EC conducted small Early College Day events before Thanksgiving to help the high schools get their students ready for YC dual enrollment classes in the spring. (Picture attached)

EC also worked with Financial Aid this fall to conduct and present live and virtual FAFSA nights to the high school partners and families.

EC and Promise teams have been working to promote Cohort 3 for the YC Promise program, and so far, 178 students have opted in for next year!

Promise, as of Mid-December, had met with over 90% of the students in the program via oneon-one advising appointments. Also, over 90% of students have completed the FAFSA application.

For Promise cohorts 1 and 2, 75% percent are registered for the spring semester.

At Convocation on January 13th, Cristina Poeppel in Early College won the YC Way award.



SSS TRIO Student Support Services

SSS TRIO awarded 36 students the 2021 Spring SSS TRIO Scholarship. These Pell-eligible students earned the award based on GPA, credit load, and participation in SSS TRIO. Applicants discussed their goals and how they are getting past academic and financial obstacles. The \$750 awards totaling \$27,000 comes through the program from the Department of Education.

Veteran Education & Transition Services

Small group workshops were provided by VET Services in the first three weeks of January to veterans and dependents using VA education benefits. These sessions helped students understand how to achieve their goals, avoid negative impacts on their benefits, and make them aware of additional support for their educational journey.
