 - a. Liz shared the definition.
 - Bachelor of Arts (BA): Focuses on the study of human society and behaviors, examining qualitative aspects of a particular field of study. Requires interdisciplinary approach with curricula that concentrates on diverse perspectives, critical thinking, and communication skills.
 - ii. Bachelor of Science (BS): Focuses on the quantitative side of subjects that deal with both scientific or mathematics and humanities-focused content. Emphasis on theoretical knowledge, analytical thinking, and research skills within the chosen field of study.

- iii. Bachelor of Applied Science (BAS): Focuses on applied skills and knowledge relevant to a specific field or industry. Includes hands-on training, internships, and real-world projects, preparing students for immediate entry into the workforce upon graduation.
- b. The committee discussed their concerns on the potential negative impact on enrollment from launching two similar programs. Additionally, concerns about the lack of a seamless transition from the AAS to the BAS were raised.
- c. It was agreed that a select team from the committee would facilitate the integration of AAS into BAS next Tuesday, with plans to report back on progress by March 5th.
