As required by A.R.S. §15-1443(B), the Board will elect a Chairperson and a Secretary every January. The expectation will be that the Chairperson and Secretary will serve a two-year term, but the Board may decide otherwise and elect a new Chairperson and Secretary every January. Mr. Ray Sigafoos, Chair, and Mr. Steve Irwin, Secretary are concluding the second year of their two-year terms.

Member Chevalier moved, seconded by Member McCasland, to appoint Member Irwin to be Chairman of the Board. Motion failed two yes votes and three no votes. (Chevalier and McCasland voting in favor and Irwin, McCarver, Sigafoos voting against.)

Member Irwin stated that he was unable to be chair for the year due to upcoming obligations and suggested Mr. Sigafoos remain Chair as a sense of continuity for the upcoming President.

Member McCarver moved, seconded by Member Irwin, to reappoint Mr. Sigafoos as Chairman. Motion carried with three yes votes and two no votes. (Irwin, McCarver, and Sigafoos voting in favor and McCasland and Chevalier voting against.)

Member Chevalier moved, seconded by Member McCasland, to appoint Ms. Deb McCasland as Secretary. Motion failed with two yes votes and three no votes. (McCasland and Chevalier voting in favor and Irwin, McCarver, Sigafoos voting against.)

Member McCarver moved, seconded by Member Irwin, to reappoint Mr. Irwin as Secretary. Motion carried with three yes votes and two no votes (Irwin, McCarver, and Sigafoos voting in favor and McCasland and Chevalier voting against.)
