Furniture is scheduled to be delivered and installed July 8-19.


There will be a Verde Valley Campus open house on August 8, followed by a grand reopening and ribbon cutting on August 13.



Center for Learning and Innovation - Prescott Campus


Demolition is nearing completion as the building transforms from a Library to a Center for Learning and Innovation.

Please keep a look out for Facilities Management newsflashes discussing important items such as construction work zones, access to the community room, YC Foundation, and CNT labs during construction.


Library staff are in building 3, rooms 105, 106, and 107, during construction of the new Center for Learning and Innovation.


FLOOR PLAN

LEVEL 2 PROGRAMMING/MULTI-PURPOSE & EXPERIMENTAL CLASSROOM




MICTED/YC Culinary Prescott Campus

The College is partnering with MICTED to renovate Building 4, Room 220, to transform this space from a science lab into a culinary lab.

Design is nearing completion with plans to begin demolition/construction in mid-July.

Construction will include modifications to the building's HVAC to accommodate a kitchen hood, new food service-related flooring, and additional electrical and plumbing to support this program's equipment and food preparation needs. There will also be modifications to ensure safety is maintained by limiting access to lab preparation areas.

Current layout of 4-220


The renovation will take approximately six months once the design is complete, with a target completion date of January 15, 2025.

BUILDINGS AND GROUNDS PLANNED MAINTENANCE PROJECTS

As part of the budget, planned maintenance projects are scheduled each year to ensure that College facilities are maintained at a level to support optimum performance in building systems and infrastructure, life safety compliance, adequate maintenance and repair of roadways, parking lots, along with College grounds. These projects result from a recent Facilities Condition Assessment (FCA), which identifies when repairs, modifications, or replacement of components should occur.

FCA Projects:

CTEC Phase 2 Restroom Renovations – complete Buildings 28, 30, 31, 32, and the Rock House; roof and/or HVAC Replacement through August 2024. Roof Replacement Marapai Residence Hall – complete Roof repairs and rooftop unit replacement Building 7 – through June 2024


