

**YAVAPAI COMMUNITY COLLEGE DISTRICT
FY 2006-07 Dual Enrollment Tracking Summary**

In FY 2005-06, the Yavapai Community College District had 330 enrollments in dual enrollment courses from six area high schools. Of those students, 294 (89%) were academically ranked as seniors and completed a dual enrollment course. In the year following graduation, 99 of this cohort were enrolled in higher education at Yavapai College. The tracking study reveals the following data when comparing the students' grade point average (GPA) while enrolled in dual enrollment coursework with their coursework at Yavapai College the year immediately following high school graduation.

2005-06 Dual Enrollment Cohort:

- Comparing recent Arizona high school graduates performance (as measured by GPA) in their first year of college, students with dual enrollment credits had a higher average GPA (2.86) than students without dual enrollment credits (2.49).
- 81% of the former academic (math or English) dual enrollment students now enrolled in academic courses at Yavapai College earned a GPA of 2.00 or better in 2006-07.
- More than 70% of the former occupational dual enrollment students now enrolled at Yavapai College in 2006-07 who completed additional occupational courses did so with a GPA of 2.00 or better.
- Overall, 90% the cohort of students who continued on at Yavapai College, had a GPA of 2.0 or higher in their dual enrollment coursework. Tracking these same students in their first year as exclusive college students, 78% of the students maintained a GPA of 2.0 or higher.
