

## Yavapai College Commercial Driver Training FAQ's

- CDL Permit and Driving classes are offered in 8-week sessions. 2 in both the Fall (Aug-Dec) & Spring (Jan-May) Semesters, and 1 in the Summer Semester (June-July). Students meet in the classroom on the first day of the session for the required orientation, then students arrange a driving schedule with the instructor. We do not train students on Saturday/Sundays.
- Tuition is \$210 for CDT250 Commercial License Prep, \$2520 for CDT255 Behind the Wheel, but if you register for both in the same semester, you only pay \$2520.
- Financial aid is available. Complete the Financial Aid application at [www.studentaid.gov](http://www.studentaid.gov) and fill out the scholarship application form located in the portal under the Students tab and My Financial Aid. - You must fill out an online application to be put on a waitlist, you must apply to be a student and get a YC ID number before you can fill out the application. The application can be found at [www.yc.edu/cdl](http://www.yc.edu/cdl). Once you click the application button, it will give you the information of how to apply.
- Once your application has been submitted, you will be put on the waitlist. Applications are accepted and processed in the order they are received. When there is a seat available, you will be contacted to register for the class, please respond and register promptly by the given deadline. Class sizes are extremely limited.
- You must have a current driver's license and an ADOT Medical Examiners Certificate prior to the first day of class; failure to do so will result in the cancellation of your application.
- You will need your original birth certificate and two other forms of ID to obtain the CDL permit.
- Currently YC offers CDL Class A & Class B training and examination.
- If you held a CDL and it has expired, and you want to get a new CDL, you will not have to complete any training and can just do the exam. If you need a refresher before taking the exam, YC offers CDT200 Commercial Driver Refresher/Extender \$420 in the 8-week sessions mentioned above.
