Hiring Process: - 2 full-time teaching positions. - Requirements: BSN with 3 years patient care experience. d. Student Recruitment/Enrollment: - Open application cycle in January 2024. - Verify certification/licensure and work experience. e. Equipment Purchases: - Simulation Equipment: Nurse Anne, Sim Mom, Sim Baby, Sim Capture, BD Pyxis Med Bank Tower, IV Pumps. f. Implementation: - Deliver the program to 120 learners from Fall 2024-Spring 2027. g. Data Collection and Record Maintenance: - Student records, policies, preceptor engagement. h. Evaluation: - Quarterly advisory meetings, review of performance measures, consideration of program continuation.

4. Performance Outcome Measures:

 Various measures including total participants served, completed program activities, earned credentials, and entered employment.

5. Open Forum:

- Discussion on the inclusion of LPNs in the Arizona Nurses Association.
- Potential for LPNs in domiciliary mental health and rehab at the VA.
